Government schools throughout New South Wales (NSW) participate in the Study Tours program providing you with a unique experience of learning and living in a safe, exciting, multicultural society. You'll be excited by what you see.

The program has been running successfully for more than 10 years. Around 10,000 students and teachers from all over the world visit NSW as part of a study tour group every year.

The hospitality of Australian students and teachers will make you feel very welcome. Our school system will introduce you to some exciting learning, social and cultural experiences.

English classes can be built into your study tour program. You will establish lasting friendships as your English improves.

Study tours can be from half a day to an extended program of 10 weeks.

Student study tour groups have at least 15 students. Adult study tour groups have at least 10 people. We can arrange focused professional development presentations by specialists within the NSW Department of Education & Training as well as group visits by adults to schools.

Australian students value meeting overseas students. Visiting students are paired with an Australian student called a "buddy". Study tour groups will have a tour of the school, classroom visits, entertainment and activities. Students experience Australian foods with morning tea or lunch. A study tour program can include lesson participation, excursions or field trips, English conversation classes and school events.

All tours are customised. Costs depend on location and activities. Specialised programs can be arranged in performing arts, technology, languages or sports high schools.

A range of accommodation is available from hostels to international hotels. Homestay accommodation allows students to live with an Australian family.

Study tour participants will require a valid tourist visa for the duration of their stay.

We recommend booking and confirming your study tour at least 12 weeks before arriving in Australia.
