## Accommodation and welfare

Students must be 15 years of age to be eligible for a Study Abroad program. All Study Abroad students live with homestay families near their school. Study Abroad students are placed in Australian Year 10 and Year 11 classes.

All homestay families are accredited and undergo a police check before students arrive. The host parent takes on the role of guardian/carer for students.

Homestay families are very welcoming. Study Abroad students often develop friendships with their host families which last for many years.

## Arrival services and support

Airport reception and transfer to the homestay host family is arranged. All schools have an International Student Coordinator who assists students to settle into their studies, helps with subject choices and with any questions about school life.

## Entry requirements

### Academic

Secondary school reports must show good grades in all subjects.

### English

A good level of English proficiency i.e. evidence such as a supporting letter from your school, or an appropriate English language test score.

### Visa

Study Abroad students must have a student visa. Contact your nearest Australian Diplomatic Mission or go to [www.immi.gov.au](http://www.immi.gov.au)
