

Temporary Residents Program



Application Process for Temporary Residents:

Students holding a temporary resident visa (including bridging visa holders, subclass 010 to 070) who are residing in New South Wales must, with their parent or guardian (if under 18 years of age), make application for enrolment directly to the government primary or secondary school nearest to their place of residence.

All temporary residents are currently not eligible to enrol in the Conservatorium High School, Selective High Schools including Agricultural High Schools, the selective component of Comprehensive High Schools and Opportunity C (OC) classes in Primary Schools.

When the family visits their local government school, they must take the following original documents to the school for copying and certification:

- The student's passport and current valid visa.
- If the student holds a bridging visa, the previous visa and documentary evidence of the new visa applied for must also be provided.

The applicant must request the school to provide a Temporary Residents Application Form to complete, or it can be downloaded from the website at www.internationalschool.edu.au prior to visiting the school.

The applicant must complete the appropriate sections of the Temporary Residents Application Form.

The school principal will complete the Principal's Verification Section of the Temporary Residents Application Form and will provide the applicant with certified copies of the student's passport and visa for submission with the application.

The applicant must post the completed Application Form, a certified copy of the student's passport, a certified copy of the student's visa and payment of the Temporary Residents Administration Fee and Education Fee to the postal address details provided below.

The applicant should keep a copy of the completed Application Form for their own records.

Most students holding a temporary resident visa are required to pay the Temporary Residents Administration Fee and Education Fee. Please refer to the Schedule of Visa Subclass & Conditions document on the website to determine if a visa subclass is considered as a fee liable category. For more information on fees, please refer to the Fees and Payment document on the website.

Subject to the completion of all requirements, an 'Authority to Enrol' document will be generated by the Temporary Residents Unit. The student cannot commence enrolment in a NSW government school until this document has been issued.
