How to apply

- Relevant prior education and training
- Demonstrated commitment to a vocational area
- Demonstrated commitment to or ability to complete the course
- Relevance of course to career intentions

(a) Relevant prior education or training

Details of any prior education or training you have completed should be indicated on the TAFE NSW International Student Application Form. You should attach certified copies of relevant academic records.

(b) Commitment to working in the relevant design field

Demonstrate your commitment to eventually work in a design field relevant to the course.

- Have you researched what this design field is about?

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Section 4

Design task

Design a product from one of the following categories:

- Sport and leisure product
- Ecological or re-cycled product
- Consumer product

Draw your initial ideas for your design on A3 size (420mm x 297mm) sheets of drawing paper. We are interested in seeing how you explore your design ideas visually. You may have many different versions of the one idea on your drawing papers.

On a separate sheet of drawing paper show your final design. We suggest the final design be coloured using coloured pencils or paints.

On all of your drawings we suggest you write notes to further explain your ideas and your final design.

Submission format

You can submit your work either as the original hard copy or in digital images on a CD-ROM:

- If submitted as original, each page must have your name clearly printed across the bottom. The application is to be submitted in a plastic folder, no larger than A3 (which is 420mm x 297mm), on which your name, address and telephone number are clearly printed on the outside of the folder.
- If submitting work digitally, ensure that the images are high quality and that they open easily in a program like PhotoShop.

Your name should be clearly marked on each piece of work you submit, as well as any containers for that work.

Criteria

The purpose of this task is to evaluate your ability and understanding of design as a process and not only as a concept.

The criteria to be used in assessing the design task are:

- Demonstrated ability to complete the tasks
- Individuality of expression
- A creative approach to problem solving
- The ability to develop design solutions
- A well developed sense of tonal or colour appreciation
- The imaginative and innovative application of ideas
- Clean and accurate skills in the presentation of work
- An imaginative use of media (at least two different media should be demonstrated).

All selection criteria apply equally.
