These requirements apply to the following courses:

- **19252** Diploma of Arts (Furniture Design)

Design courses at TAFE NSW are in high demand by both Australian and international students. Places are limited and entry is subject to a selection process that includes assessment of one or more design tasks.

How to apply

To apply for a design course you must complete and submit the following:

1. **TAFE NSW International Student Application Form**
Attach any required supporting documentation. Note that an English language competency requirement of IELTS 6.0 applies to applications for the above design courses.
2. **This form**
Please ensure you have completed sections 1, 2 and 3 and have printed your name clearly across the bottom of each page.
3. **Your original design work in the format specified**
See section 4 below for specific details of requirements. Your name should be clearly marked on each piece of work you submit, as well as any containers for that work.

- Relevant prior education and training
- Demonstrated commitment to a vocational area
- Demonstrated commitment to or ability to complete the course
- Relevance of course to career intentions

(a) Relevant prior education or training

Selection criteria

Your application will be assessed using the following selection criteria:

- An imaginative use of media (at least two different media should be demonstrated)
- Individuality of expression
- A creative approach to problem solving
- The ability to develop Design solutions
- A well developed sense of 3 Dimensional design applications
- A well developed sense of colour appreciation
- Demonstrated awareness of Furniture Design profession and extent of previous studies/experience in related areas

Design task

You must submit some original work for assessment. When choosing your portfolio please keep in mind the above criteria. You must submit **at least 4 but no more than 10** examples of your work. You can submit either;

- Original examples of your work, this could be drawings or designs. Your work is to be no larger than A3 size (297mm x 420mm) and you must write your name on each piece of work and submit it in a plastic folder with your name written on front.

Or

- You can submit photographs or slides of your original designs. Slides should be in a 35mm format and inserted in a plastic slide holder. Photographs should be 8 x 10 format. All your work must have your name clearly printed on each piece and submitted in a plastic folder that has your name clearly written on the front.
